Singapore Cooperation Programme

Singapore has provided technical assistance to other developing countries since the 1960s. As a country whose only resource is its people, Singapore believes that human resource development is vital for economic and social progress. Singapore itself has benefited from training provided by other countries and international organisations.

In 1992, the Singapore Cooperation Programme (SCP) was established to bring together under one framework the various technical assistance programmes offered by Singapore. Through the SCP, the range and number of training programmes were increased to share Singapore's development experience with other developing countries.

To date, more than 150,000 officials from more than 180 developing countries, territories, and intergovernmental organisations have participated in our courses and study visits. The SCP is managed by the Technical Cooperation Directorate of the Singapore Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Kazakhstan Agency of International Development (KazAID)

The Republic of Kazakhstan has been providing assistance to countries in Central Asia and beyond since gaining its independence. In order to systematize Kazakhstan's efforts to provide financial, technical and other types of assistance, Kazakhstan adopted the Law on Official Development Assistance (ODA) in December 2014. Thus, Kazakhstan became the first country among the members of the Commonwealth of Independent States to adopt a national law regulating the ODA policy.

Kazakhstan Agency of International Development "KazAID" is a national operator of the Republic of Kazakhstan in the field of Official Development Assistance (ODA) established in December 2020, which operates under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

The purposes of Kazakhstan development cooperation efforts include strengthening peace, regional and global security as well as socioeconomic development of the partner countries with



the focus on Central Asia and improvement of the welfare of its citizens.

KazAID specializes in provision of technical assistance, administration of grants, facilitation of technological advancement and economic growth through implementation of the projects in the field of ODA for the partner countries' sustainable development.

Civil Service College, Singapore

Civil Service College (CSC) is the central learning institution for the Singapore Public Service. It plays a pivotal role in nurturing and developing people for a first-class Public Service. As a Statutory Board under the Prime Minister's Office, we endeavour to be the heart of learning excellence and development for the Singapore Public Service.

CSC offers a comprehensive suite of programmes that build strategic capability in the public service, focusing particularly on core areas in public governance, leadership, public administration and management. We work closely with central government and public sector agencies to embed values, communicate public sector directions, and manage change in individuals and organisations.

CSC partners public and private sector organisations as well as academia and international government agencies to exchange best practices and experiences in leadership, policy development, public administration and public reform.

Course Objectives

This programme will explore the use of technology to streamline governmental processes, improve public outcomes, discuss opportunities and challenges in digitalising government, economy and society as well as building public service capability to support digital transformation.

Course Outline

This course topics will include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Traditional and new challenges in public administration
- Opportunities and challenges in digitalising government, economy and society

- Effective governance development trends in Central Asia (e.g. Kazakhstan's digital governance model)
- Utilisation of big data, AI, robotics and data analytics to improve public service outcomes and service delivery in Singapore
- Whole-of-Nation effort in harnessing technology to transform public service in Singapore and Kazakhstan

Methodology

The course will be conducted in person in the capital of Kazakhstan, Astana, and will include the delivery of instruction of course sessions, group discussions, sharing sessions, case studies, experiential activities, and other learning methodologies.

Course Duration and Venue

This course will be conducted from 1 to 5 April 2024 in Astana, Kazakhstan.

Invited Countries

The Republic of Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz Republic, Republic of Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Republic of Uzbekistan.

Application Information

Applicants should be:

- Mid-to-senior level government officials involved in the formulation and implementation of policies related to digital governance and/or driving digital transformation within their respective public agency or at the wider civil service level
- Nominated by their government
- Proficient in English
- In good health
- Prepared to participate actively in the programme

Terms of Award

This course is sponsored by the Government of Singapore and the Government of Kazakhstan under the Singapore-Kazakhstan MOU on Cooperation on Capacity Building Programme for



Government Officials of the C5 countries.

The Governments of Singapore and Kazakhstan will bear the following expenses for successful applicants, thereafter, known as "participants", during the course in Kazakhstan.

These expenses include:

- Course fees, including lecture fees, administrative fees, and course materials.
- Accommodation for the entire duration of the course. Complimentary breakfast will be provided in the hotel.
- Meal and a daily per diem from the first day to the last day of the course.
- Transportation to the training venue and site visits during the course period.
- Accommodation, per diem and transportation costs are covered for participants travelling to Kazakhstan and are not envisaged for the residents of Kazakhstan.
- Basic insurance coverage for the duration of the course in Kazakhstan, in accordance with the policy of a local insurance company. This does not cover any pre-existing conditions/ illnesses and/or any outpatient medical/dental treatment. Participants are personally liable for all medical expenses beyond what is covered by the insurance policy.

Note:

- The flight costs are to be covered by the participants;
- Participants are to bear their personal expenses that might be incurred prior to receiving the allowance; and
- As the basic insurance coverage is limited, participants are strongly advised to purchase comprehensive travel insurance which includes adequate coverage of COVID-19 related expenses and medical evacuation in the event of any unexpected emergencies.

Regulations

Participants are required to comply with the following:

• Strictly observe course schedules and not miss course sessions;

- Carry out instructions and abide by such conditions as may be stipulated by the nominating Authority or Governments of Singapore and Kazakhstan with respect to the course.
- Not to engage in political activities, or any form of employment for profit or gain while in Kazakhstan.
- Discontinue the course, in the event that they fall seriously ill and are considered unable to continue the course or have committed an improper act.
- Return to their respective home countries upon completion of the course.

Application Procedure

Selection of candidates will be based on merit. Should there be more applicants than course places, the Governments of Singapore and Kazakhstan seek the understanding of the respective National Focal Points for Technical Assistance if their nominee(s) is not selected.
